Jack Eason Rowe Jr., of Fletcher, passed away December 1, 2022, at the Solace Center in Asheville. He was 80 years old.

He was born on June 3, 1942, in Bossier City, Louisiana, the son of Jack Eason Rowe Sr. and Bessie Rita (Bienvenu) Rowe.

Jack served as a Captain in the Air Force in Korea during the Vietnam War era. He earned a Doctorate in Counseling Psychology and taught college-level courses. He had a great love of teaching. One of his greatest joys was teaching people how to do EFT (Emotional Freedom Techniques), which is tapping on acupuncture points to help heal emotional and physical traumas.

Jack shared love and joy with his wife, Linda, since 1992 and had been married since December 30, 1993. He enjoyed mini-adventures over the years with his wife, Linda, such as paragliding, flying in an open cockpit bi-plane, and touring many national parks. Their adventures included two trips to Hawaii, one to Maui and one to beautiful Kauai.

Jack enjoyed visits with both his family and Linda's family over the years. He was proud to have worked with grandsons, Ryan and AJ, to build a bridge over a gully on his property in Oklahoma. Jack enjoyed delightful visits with his grandson Joshua over the years. Jack often said how proud he was of

both of his daughters.

He was preceded in death by his father, Jack Eason Rowe Sr., and his mother, Bessie Rita (Bienvienu) Rowe.

Surviving family members include his wife, Linda Rowe; daughters, Shannon Wright (Chris), and Marvelyn Bucky (Scott); and grandsons, Ryan, AJ, and Joshua.
