Judithann "Judi" Choiley Milton, 78, of Fletcher, passed away on Thursday, December 23, 2021 at Pardee Hospital. Judi was born on June 1, 1943 in Orlando, Florida.

Her family relocated to Long Island, NY where Judi graduated from Baldwin High School in Baldwin, NY in 1961. In 1963 the Choiley's moved their family to Hollywood, FL where Judi began a career in banking. She married James Milton in February 1970 and they welcomed their daughter Jennifer Lori Milton in August 1975. After their divorce in 1977 she continued to live in Hollywood working for what was then Caribank. Family was her number one priority. Judi will be remembered for her unconditional love for her daughter Jennifer and her grandchildren who lovingly called her Grammy.
