Marcus Reign McQuaig, age 43, passed away on February 24, 2024, in Asheville, North Carolina. He was born on June 16, 1980, in Mission Viejo, California to Isaac “Mark” and Linda (Boaz) McQuaig.

Marcus served in the United States Air Force from August 26, 1998, to July 31, 2014. He was an Oral Surgery Technician specializing in Head and Neck Trauma. His service included a tour of duty treating the wounded in Iraq. He was deeply moved by the injured soldiers in his care.

After leaving the Air Force, he furthered his education, receiving an Associate Degree in Medical Coding and Billing at Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College and a Management degree at William Carey University. He then continued his work in the dental field by assisting his wife in managing their family’s dental practice.

He was survived by his loving wife, Jessica, and his children, Savannah, Dylan, and Lillian. Marcus is also survived by his sister, Ramona (Randy) Corsaro, and her children, Michael and Stephen; his sister-in-law, Amanda Wood, brothers-in-law, Thomas Christy and David Christy. He was preceded in death by his parents.

He was a caring person known for his great sense of humor, kindness, and

intelligence. He will be greatly missed by all who loved and knew him.
