



## Olen Frederick Paschall Jr.

January 23, 1948 - May 26, 2023

Olen Frederick Paschall, Jr. "Fred", 75, passed away in his home in Asheville, North Carolina on Friday, May 26, 2023, after a brief illness.

Born in Walterboro, South Carolina, on January 23, 1948, the only child to the late Olen and Eloise Paschall. He graduated from Bells High School in Lodge, South Carolina, in 1968, and from Vanderbilt University Scarritt College in 1972. He was a retired Chief Boatswain's Mate in the United States Coast Guard having proudly served in Operation Desert Storm. He was also employed by the Lorain County Court system until his retirement in 2006. Olen had a passion for aviation and flying and was a commercial pilot and flight instructor for many years.
