



Terry Earl Burnworth

April 22, 1943 - May 6, 2024

Fletcher, NC — Terry Earl Burnworth, aged 81, passed away peacefully on May 16, 2024, surrounded by his family. Born on April 22, 1943, in Akron, OH, and raised in Confluence, PA, Terry's life was marked by dedication, service, and unwavering faith.

Terry was born to Lorraine Burnworth of Uniontown, PA, and the late Earl "Pete" Burnworth, Jr. He proudly served his country as a veteran of the US Air Force and dedicated 32 years to civil service, residing in Derwood and Gaithersburg, MD, before retiring to Concord, NC, in 1993. Terry's sense of duty and commitment didn't end there; he continued to work for another 16 years, finally retiring for a second time in 2010.

A faithful member of Crossroads Church in Concord, NC, for over 20 years, Terry was deeply involved in the church community, serving in various capacities and as a Gideon. The Bower small group was particularly dear to him. His faith and service were cornerstones of his life, leaving a lasting impact on those who knew him.

He is survived by his devoted wife, Carol Saunders Burnworth, of the home; his daughter, Robin; his granddaughter, Halcyon; his mother, Lorraine Burnworth; his sister, Judith Thomas, of Uniontown, PA; and numerous nieces, nephews, and cousins.

Terry was preceded in death by his father, Earl "Pete" Burnworth, Jr., and his son-in-law, Jacob Nathaniel Brown.

A celebration of Terry's life will be held at 11 am on June 24, 2024, at Crossroads Church in Concord, NC. Additionally, a memorial will take place in Uniontown, PA, at Venue 67 on June 28th from 4:30 pm to 7:30 pm.
